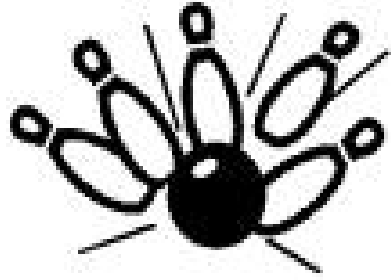

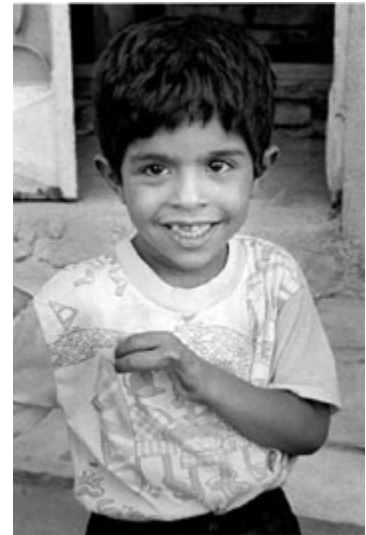

Above are photos of Um Haider and her eight-year-old son, Mostafa. A US missile slammed into their residential neighborhood of Basra City on January 25, 1999, severely injuring Mostafa and killing his brother, Haider. Most Americans are not aware that the United States has bombed Iraq routinely ever since the end of the First Gulf War. Civilian carnage caused by these attacks has gone virtually unreported in the U.S. media. According to UNICEF, sanctions enforced by the United States contributed to the deaths of hundreds of thousands of children. This too has been largely unreported. Sanctions have degraded Iraq's medical system and deprived the Iraqi people of essential medical services. Many victims of US military assault have not received medical care for their injuries due to the most punishing sanctions regime in human history.
